



SELECT PERFORMANCE PARTS LIMITED WARRANTY

Ford Motor Company, The American Road, Dearborn, MI 48025, provides a Limited Warranty on select Ford Racing performance parts as described herein when installed on late model Ford vehicles. This warranty works in conjunction with the Manufacturer's New Vehicle Limited Warranty. It is valid for the original retail purchaser of the vehicle and is transferable to subsequent vehicle owners.

Warranted Superchargers

Superchargers are warranted for factory-supplied material or workmanship, when installed by an authorized Ford or Lincoln Dealer or Shelby Automotive, Inc, beginning upon dealer installation and registration of the part(s) with Ford Racing and ends at either **12 months or 12,000 miles / 20,000 kilometres**, whichever occurs first. Installation must occur prior to the vehicle reaching either 24 months or 24,000 miles / 40,000 kilometres, whichever occurs first, from the beginning of the manufacturer's New Vehicle Limited Warranty. This Limited Warranty replaces the existing manufacturer's New Vehicle Limited Warranty for engine, driveline and suspension parts when a concern is triggered by a warranted Ford Racing Supercharger. All engine, driveline and suspension warranty issues not related to installation of Ford Racing Superchargers remain subject to existing manufacturer's New Vehicle Limited Warranty.

The Ford Racing Limited Warranty covers the following select superchargers:

Select Performance Parts Special Warranty Restrictions

Premium Fuel Requirement: Customers who purchase Power Upgrade Packs, TrackKey, or Superchargers are required to use 91-octane or higher fuels at all times. Any failures associated with the non-use of premium 91-octane fuel will be ineligible for warranty repair.

Supercharger Application: Superchargers are covered by this Limited Warranty only when dealer installed on the engine for which they were designed.

- 400 HP Superchargers are designed to be installed on Mustang GT 4.6L engines.
- 525 HP Superchargers are designed to be installed on Mustang GT 5.0L engines and Shelby GT350 5.0L engines.
- 605 HP and 660 HP Superchargers are designed to be installed on Shelby GT500 5.4L engines.

Ford Racing total aggregated liability per qualified vehicle under this Limited Warranty is \$8,000: Each covered component has its own aggregate value, which when combined shall not exceed \$8,000 in total parts repairs, except in the Province of Quebec, where the cost of parts and labor are covered. The maximum liability for failed parts by component category under this Limited Warranty is as follows: engine assembly parts \$5,000, transmission assembly \$1,500, and rear axle assembly \$1,500. Under this Limited Warranty, Ford Racing retains the right to replace any failed components with remanufactured parts for the life of the warranty.

Warranty Registration: This limited warranty requires that parts must be purchased from an authorized Ford Racing Dealer and installed by a Ford or Lincoln Dealer, or Shelby Automotive, Inc. Proof of purchase may be required for submission of warranty claims. Registration for this warranty must be submitted by a Ford Dealer, or Shelby Automotive, Inc. through the Ford Performance Call Center (800)367-3788 or fwrnty@ford.com with Dealer P&A Code, the vehicle identification number (VIN), part installation repair order and date, Ford Racing part number, and owner information.



Limitations to Ford Racing Performance Parts Warranty

The following limitations apply to the products covered by this Limited Warranty:

- The purchase invoice(s) may be required for submission of warranty claims.
- Where a warranted Ford Racing part is replaced under this Limited Warranty, the replacement Ford Racing part is warranted only for the time remaining in the original Limited Warranty.
- This warranty does not cover parts with:
 - Damage or corrosion due to accidents, misuse, negligence, lack of proper maintenance or failure to follow maintenance schedule intervals. Proof of proper maintenance is the owner's responsibility. Keep all receipts and be prepared to make them available if questions arise about maintenance.
 - Damage or surface corrosion from the environment such as acid rain, airborne fallout (chemicals, tree sap), stones, salt road hazards, wind storm, lightning, floods and other natural disasters.
 - Normal wear, tear or deterioration such as discoloration, fading, or blurring.
 - Damage as a result of misuse of a vehicle, such as driving over curbs, overloading, racing or using the vehicle as a stationary power source.
 - Damage due to improper installation, alteration, including calibration, use related to racing or competition, marine or motorcycle applications, or other non-vehicle usage.
- This warranty does not cover:
 - Non-Ford Racing parts or Genuine Ford replacement parts or accessories which Ford Dealers may sell or install on your Ford vehicle.
 - Parts replaced or labor charges incurred as part of normal vehicle maintenance.
 - Engine damage associated with use of less than 91-octane fuels.
 - Replacement parts or accessories installed on a Ford vehicle in which the odometer has been altered, or on which the actual mileage cannot be readily determined.
 - Replacement parts or accessories used in applications for which they are not designed.
 - Towing, shipping, rental vehicles, loss of time, inconvenience, loss of use or other economic loss to the extent allowed by law, except in the Province of Quebec where reasonable costs of towing and shipping are covered.
 - Parts installed in vehicles registered and/or normally operated outside the United States or Canada.
- Should Ford Racing modify any currently released parts which apply to this warranty program, Ford Racing is not obligated to update any previously manufactured parts.
- In the Province of Quebec, none of the limitations and exclusions above exclude or restrict the warranty provided for in sections 37 and 38 of the Quebec Consumer Protection Act.

NOTE: Federal and many state and provincial laws prohibit the removal, modification or rendering inoperative of any part that effects emissions or safety on motor vehicles used on public streets or highways. Ford Racing customers are responsible for complying with applicable federal, state, provincial and local environmental laws, including but not limited to, with respect to vehicle emissions. It is the responsibility of the customer to determine if their modified vehicle complies with applicable laws.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS. YOU MAY HAVE OTHER RIGHTS THAT VARY FROM STATE TO STATE AND PROVINCE TO PROVINCE. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS THE ONLY EXPRESS WARRANTY APPLICABLE TO THESE PARTS. FORD RACING AND FORD MOTOR COMPANY ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY TIME FOR WHICH YOU MAY LOSE THE USE OF YOUR VEHICLE, ANY INCONVENIENCE YOU MIGHT BE CAUSED, THE LOSS OF YOUR TRANSPORTION OR ANY PART THEREOF, OR ANY OTHER INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES YOU MAY HAVE. YOU MAY HAVE SOME IMPLIED WARRANTIES UNDER STATE OR PROVINCIAL LAW, FOR EXAMPLE, THE IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR THE IMPLIED WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
